Wedding Videography Contract

Rubix Media Group t/a Moments Wedding Films

This contract is between **Rubix Media Group t/a Moments Wedding Films** (the "Videographer") and the client(s) named at the end of this document (the "Client"). By paying the booking fee, the Client confirms they have read, understood, and agreed to these terms.

1. Booking Fee

A non-refundable, non-transferable booking fee of £50 is required to secure the date. This fee:

- Is deducted from the total package price on the final invoice
- Is forfeited if the booking is cancelled for reasons other than health or force majeure
- Is retained if the wedding is postponed, subject to the Videographer's availability on the new date
- Will be refunded in full, along with any other payments made, if the Videographer cancels

2. Package & Payment Schedule

The agreed package and pricing will be confirmed in writing at the time of booking. Payment is structured as follows:

- Booking fee (£50): Due on signing — secures the date
- 50% deposit of remaining balance: Due no later than four weeks before the wedding date
- Final balance: Due within 30 days of delivery of the completed video(s)

The Videographer reserves the right to withhold delivery of final files until all outstanding balances are settled.

3. Wedding Day Details

Full details of the wedding day schedule (ceremony times, venue addresses, key contacts) must be provided at least two weeks before the wedding by written communication, Zoom call, or phone. The Client must notify the Videographer promptly in writing of any changes to these details.

4. Cancellation

Cancellations must be made in writing. The following terms apply:

- All payments made are non-refundable upon cancellation, except where cancellation is due to a documented medical reason or a force majeure event, in which case a full refund will be issued
- Postponements are treated as a cancellation and re-booking; the original booking fee will be applied to the new date, subject to availability

5. Force Majeure

Neither party is liable for failure to perform their obligations where such failure results from circumstances beyond their reasonable control (including but not limited to natural disaster, severe weather, pandemic, government restriction, or venue access issues). In such cases, both parties will make reasonable efforts to

reschedule. The Videographer is not liable for loss of footage caused by equipment malfunction, provided all reasonable precautions and regular maintenance checks have been undertaken.

6. Attendance & Substitution

The Videographer will make every effort to attend the wedding personally. In the event of illness or emergency, Moments Wedding Films reserves the right to appoint a substitute videographer of comparable skill and experience, without affecting the terms of this contract. The Client will be notified as soon as practicable.

7. Creative Rights & Editing

By engaging Moments Wedding Films, the Client grants the Videographer full creative discretion over shot composition, filming direction, and editing style. All editing is carried out by Luke Tyrrell and typically requires up to 25 hours of post-production.

The final video will be delivered within eight weeks of the wedding date. Every effort will be made to deliver sooner.

One round of minor amendments (e.g. music changes, sequence adjustments) is included. Additional revision requests beyond this may be subject to an additional fee, agreed in writing before work commences.

8. Delivery

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, the final video will be delivered digitally via an online link and on a USB drive. Alternative or additional delivery formats are available upon request and may incur an additional charge.

9. Raw Footage & Storage

All raw footage will be securely stored for 12 months from the wedding date, after which it may be permanently deleted with no obligation to retain or recover it. Should the Client wish to obtain the raw footage, they may request either:

- A copy of the raw files, or
- A raw footage edit (additional fee applies)

All such requests must be made in writing within the 12-month storage window.

10. Music Licensing

Where licensed music is used in the final video, the Videographer will use tracks from licensed music platforms (e.g. Musicbed, Artlist). The Client may suggest music preferences, but the Videographer cannot guarantee the use of specific commercially copyrighted tracks due to licensing restrictions. The Client accepts full responsibility for any copyright claims arising from specific music they request outside of licensed platforms.

11. Promotional Use & Privacy

The Videographer may use short clips or screenshots from the final video for portfolio, website, and social media purposes, unless the Client objects in writing before the wedding date. No footage will be sold or licensed to third parties without explicit written consent from the Client. All data collected is processed in accordance with applicable UK GDPR legislation.

12. Limitation of Liability

Moments Wedding Films holds full public liability and professional indemnity insurance. In the event of total equipment failure, cancellation, or any other circumstances giving rise to a claim, each party's liability is limited to the total value of this contract. Neither party shall be liable for indirect, consequential, or special losses.

13. Governing Law & Dispute Resolution

This contract is governed by the laws of England and Wales. In the event of a dispute, both parties agree to first attempt resolution through good-faith negotiation. If unresolved within 30 days, either party may refer the matter to a mediator before pursuing formal legal proceedings.

14. Entire Agreement

These terms constitute the entire agreement between Moments Wedding Films and the Client, superseding all prior discussions and understandings. No variation to this contract is valid unless agreed in writing and signed by both parties.
